Year End Report

During the 2015-2016 School Year the School Council at St. Stephen's has had a successful year. Here are some other highlights of their work this past year.

1. The School Council played an integral role in St. Stephen's being able to offer a choir program to two groups. We were able to have a Grade 2-Grade 5 Choir and Grade 7- Grade 9 Choir. Parent Council shared the cost for the instructor to come into the school. Also with the support of Parent Council we were able to offer a weekly music program to the ECS and Grade 1 classes.
2. Parent Council purchased, built and will install 2 Buddy Benches for the Elementary Playground.
3. The Parent Council supported the start up of a Lego Robotics program for Junior High. They shared the cost with Royal Purple of the 10 Lego Robotic kits which were purchased.
4. Parent Council purchased items to create a basket to donate for a silent auction at the ACSTA Conference. The money raised from this auction went to Toonies for Tuition and Development & Peace.
5. The Parent Council sponsored supper for the teachers during a Parent/Teacher Interview evening.
6. The Parent Council sponsored pizza and drinks for after school when the teachers stayed to decorate for the Christmas Concert.
7. The membership has been active in recruiting new parents and students for the school.
8. As per school procedures the Council reviewed the Administrative Procedures that are of significance to them.
9. The Parent Council reviewed St. Stephen's Educational Plan.
